Parents Responsibilities



1. Leave the used shoes outside the house, and use clean shoes inside.



2. Create a receiving area for purchased items for disinfection before taking them inside the house and train the house help on how to disinfect groceries and safe disposal of the shopping bags.



3. Postpone maintenance work, and if necessary, take safety measures with the maintenance worker.



4. Store sanitizers and PPE (gloves and masks) where it is accessible by the family members and the house help.



5. Put reminder notes or posters to wash hands and to use sanitizers before entering the house for the family.



6. Always motivate your family by giving instructions for the children or organize a family meeting that would boost the morale of the family and create awareness.



7. Ensure disinfecting surfaces that are constantly used such as door, handles, cupboards, TV Remotes, phones etc. especially before and after using.



8. Expose your laundry and any items suspected to be infected, to direct sunlight.



9. Supervise and remind the house help of the importance of disinfection, ask about their families in their home countries and offer help if possible.



10. Send awareness text messages to the house help in their language to motivate them.



11. Stay connected with your friends and family on social media while maintaining social distancing and exchange tips and awareness messages from reliable sources.
